House bill A1278- in Civil Service law to support S4434
Civil Service law 75 to terminate officers for cause
Daniel's Law (NYS)***
The Elder Parole and Fair & Timely Parole Acts

***JSTF affirmed that we are in support of Daniel's Law. ACTION: A letter in support can be written, (and our web site can reflect this).

ACTION: Jonathan N is creating a spreadsheet to track the issues listed below; Brigit Hurley will support Jonathan with her access to a portal that shows status and updates on NYS bills.

The meeting was highly productive. Brainstormed ways to collaborate among ROC's grassroots organizations. JSTF should/could consider rallying around these campaigns --

Fair and Timely Parole

 Elder Parole - Elder early release - over 55 years old with +15 yrs incarceration, can get an individual parole hearing based on their accomplishments while incarcerated.

We brainstormed on:

(1) A series of 4 live "town halls" (zoom as bacup)

- 1. Faith & Redemption, centering the voices of faith leaders and people deserving second chances
- 2.Centering the voices of victims and survivors and them not wanting perpetual punishment for those who harmed them
- 3. Centering the voices of violence interrupters and public safety and how bringing our elders home increases public safety
- 4. Parole survivors who've contributed to community since release.

RocACTS can bring in members, JSTF, Clergy.

(2) Knock on doors - date and flyer coming

Especially to target constituents of Brouk and Harry Bronson who've not yet fully supported these bills.



(3) Great organizing tool - Will be a screening in ROC date tbd.

The Interview (22 mins) - advocacy video (Oprah involved)

(Can also do individual screenings - cannot be shared on social media yet as pre-release.)

Discussed who to invite - RocACTS can bring congregations, clergy, etc.

It is Important to invite Sandra Doorley who opposes both bills, and especially Whites should be represented as Sandra is White.

- (5) Certificates of accomplishment for Parolees :)
